FOREIGN ENTRIES—JAPAN CUP DIRT

The following horses entered in the 2007 Japan Cup Dirt completed quarantine and departed the Shiroi International Quarantine facilities at 11:26, arriving at Tokyo Race Course at 13:27 this afternoon. The comments from their connections taken upon arrival are as follows;

At Tokyo Racecourse

JACK SULLIVAN (USA, g6, chestnut)

“His stay in Shiroi was very good. The ride from Shiroi here to Tokyo was very slow, but he’s used to long truck rides so it’s not much of a problem.

The food here is a bit different but it’s good. The water is good and he’s eating and drinking well.

It’s the first time in Japan for the horse, not to mention myself, so tomorrow we may canter, but first I want to let him just look around and get acquainted with his surroundings.

Everybody (trainer, owner) is coming on next Wednesday or Thursday.”

KANDIDATE (GBR, h5, bay)

“There was no problem with the journey here. Everything is running smoothly. He lost 13 kg’s coming to Japan but that’s okay because he’s a big eater and he’s eating very well now.

I’ve been here before and know the course, so we’re planning to canter on the dirt tomorrow.

The trainer is expected to come on Thursday.”
