**March 26, 2008 (Wednesday)**

**KARASI (IRE, g13, bay)**

-jogged 1 lap, cantered 2 1/2 laps, jogged 1/2 lap (dirt course)  
-cantered from 3rd corner, jumped obstacles no.1, no.2 and no.3 on steeple chase course  
(exercised from 7:40 to 8:11, ridden by Bret Scott)

“He’s good compared to his last three visits. I’m very happy with the way he jumped. Bret rode him just to have a look at the fences because he hasn’t seen any since last year and he said he was very happy with him (Karasi).”

Pegasus is a speed race, and since he’s only been in flat races back home, the other horses may be faster, but he’s a different horse when he’s in Japan than when he is in Australia, so he’ll be hard to beat.”
