## 10th NAKAYAMA GRAND JUMP

### Training Report of Foreign Entrees

**April 15, 2008 (Tuesday)**

**GLIDING (NZ, g8, bay)**

--jogged 1 lap on the dirt track  
(exercised from 7:55 to 8:08 and ridden by P. Young)

“The horse is looking great. He's eating well and very calm after moving her from Shiroy. It's good that he's keeping the weight. I like the Nakayama course. It's very beautiful and I like the way how the fence is set up.

I've heard it's going to rain again later this week. That works out perfect for us. Softer ground is better.

Because he performed well yesterday, we'll just move him easy tomorrow. Jog and light canter included.”

※ALARM CALL (FRA, g8, bay) left the quarantine station at 10:00 this morning and arrived at the international stables at Nakayama Race Course at 10:39 a.m.

Comments from the connections of the French jumper upon arrival were as follows:

**ALARM CALL (FR, g8, bay)**

“The trainer will arrive tomorrow so I expect he will be here for training on Thursday but I believe the jockey won't be coming until Friday. His (Alarm Call) gallop is scheduled to be on Thursday but we don't plan to jump him.

He'd put on 6 kilos since his arrival when we scaled him yesterday (416 kg)...we don't weigh him back in France so we don't know what his best weight is meant to be, but his appearance hasn't changed much.”
